1st July 2023 – 31st December 2024

Official Trio programme

The trio of Presidencies - Spain, Belgium and Hungary - will work together to find common solutions to the challenges and tasks ahead.

The Russian war of aggression against Ukraine combined with increasing global uncertainty require the European Union to enhance its resilience and strategic autonomy.

This means:

- Reinforcing the EU's global competitiveness by strengthening our industrial base in line with the green and digital transitions and making use of innovation;
- Ensuring the twin transitions are fair, just and inclusive by enhancing the social dimension of Europe, including by addressing the demographic challenge;
- Strengthening international partnerships, multilateral cooperation, and security in all its dimensions, as well as building up an ambitious and balanced trade policy, whilst defending EU interests more assertively, based on our values, and strengthening the EU's capability to act in the field of security and defence.

Official Trio programme

AS FOR EDUCATION AND TRAINING:

The trio will make provision for strengthening lifelong learning opportunities, making education and training inclusive and accessible to all.

Particular attention will be paid to re-skilling and up-skilling opportunities for European citizens to prepare them to cope with future transformations in society, the economy and the labour market.

The trio will continue to further develop digital education and training.
