CURRICULUM VITAE

Dr. Erkinxon Rahmatullozoda was born in Tajikistan on the 10 May 1953.

In 1974, Dr. Rahmatullozoda graduated with honors from the Tajik National University with a degree in Oriental studies. He also completed special courses for senior management of the Diplomatic academy of MFA of Russian Federation in 1988 after which he secured his PhD in Political Science at Moscow State University in 1999 and, subsequently, his post-doctorate degree at the Diplomatic Academy of MFA of Russian Federation in 2008.

Professional career:

- 1974-1976 Teacher of English language at High school
- 1976-1980 Referent-interpreter at the Embassy of Soviet Union in Egypt
- 1980-1986 Executive officer in Tajik SSR's Prime minister's office
- 1986-1992 Deputy Minister of Foreign Affairs of Tajik SSR
- 1992-2001 First Deputy Minister of Foreign Affairs of Republic of Tajikistan
- 2001-2014 State advisor to the President of Republic of Tajikistan on foreign policy
- 2014-Present Assistant to the President of Republic of Tajikistan on foreign policy

Diplomatic Rank:

Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary (1993).

He has been awarded the Order of 'Sharaf (Honour) of Republic of Tajikistan of highest degree and is Chevalier of National Order of Merit (France). He has also been awarded numerous national and international honors, including two gold medals of Islamic Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (ISESCO).

Dr. Rahmatullozoda is a specialist in the field of multilateral and preventive diplomacy and has authored numerous books and publications in the mentioned field. He is fluent in English, Arabic, Farsi, Russian and Uzbek.
