 - Examination of a revised text¹

¹ When examining the revised text of the digital content proposal, delegations are invited to keep in mind the relevant Articles dealing with the respective matter in the proposal for a Directive on certain aspects concerning contracts for the online and other distance sales of goods (doc. 15252/15) focusing on the need to align as much as possible the two regimes as divergences should be introduced only as far as necessary to adequately address the specific nature of digital content (see point 4 of the political guidelines, doc. 9768/16), taking into account that the Working Party has not yet held the first Article by Article reading of that proposal.

- (a) Conformity criteria (Articles 6, 6a, 7 and 8)
- (b) Supply of digital content and failure to supply (Articles 5 and 11)
- (c) Remedies for the lack of conformity (Article 12)
- (d) Modalities of the exercise of remedies (Articles 13, 13a and 13b)
- (e) Burden of proof (Article 9)
- (f) Limitation in time (Article 10(2))
