1. The General Secretariat of the Council has been informed of the resignation of Ms Alexandra KRAMER as member of the above Committee in the trade union representatives category (for Germany).
2. Under Article 24 of Regulation (EU) No 492/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 5 April 2011 on freedom of movement for workers within the Union, members and alternate members are appointed by the Council.

3. In accordance with the usual procedure, the Government of Germany has nominated the following candidate for the remainder of the current term of office, ending on 24 September 2020¹:

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN UNION,

Having regard to Regulation (EU) No 492/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 5 April 2011 on freedom of movement for workers within the Union², and in particular Articles 23 and 24 thereof.

Whereas:

- (1) In its Decisions of 28 September 2018³, 15 October 2018⁴, 19 November 2018⁵ and 18 February 2019⁶, the Council appointed the members and alternate members of the Advisory Committee on Freedom of Movement for Workers for the period ending on 24 September 2020.
- (2) A seat as member in the trade union representatives category has fallen vacant as a result of the resignation of Ms Alexandra KRAMER.
- (3) The Government of Germany has submitted a nomination for the vacant seat,
