Subject: Consultation of the Council on the appointment of one new European Coordinator for the trans-European transport network (TEN-T)
- Decision to use the written procedure for the adoption

1. By letter addressed to the Presidency of the Council on 26 October 2020¹, the Commission consulted the Council on the appointment of Ms Inés AYALA SENDER as European Coordinator for the Rhine-Danube Core Network Corridor of the trans-European transport network, replacing Ms Karla PEIJS, in accordance with Article 45(1) of Regulation (EU) No 1315/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 11 December 2013 on Union guidelines for the development of the trans-European transport network and repealing Decision No 661/2010/EU².
2. Consequently, the members of the Working Party on Transport-Intermodal Questions and Networks were consulted at the informal videoconference held on 13 November 2020.
3. As a result of the consultation, all delegations expressed a favourable opinion on this appointment.
