Subject: Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) No .../.. of 6.11.2012 supplementing Regulation (EU) No 510/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council with regard to rules for the application for a derogation from the specific CO2 emissions targets for new light commercial vehicles

- Intention not to raise objection to a delegated act

1. The Commission has submitted the above delegated act¹ to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and with Article 11(7) of Regulation (EU) No 510/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 11 May 2011 setting emission performance standards for new light commercial vehicles as part of the Union's integrated approach to reduce CO2 emissions from light-duty vehicles². The Commission having notified the delegated act on 6 November 2012, the Council may object to it until 6 January 2013.
2. The Working Party on Environment has examined the delegated act and agreed that there are no grounds for the Council to object to it.

3. It is therefore suggested that Coreper recommend that the Council confirm that it has no intention to object to the delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof. This implies that, unless the European Parliament objects to it, the delegated act shall be published and enter into force on the twentieth day following its publication in the Official Journal of the European Union in accordance with Article 17(2) of Regulation (EU) No 510/2011 and Article 8 of the draft Delegated Regulation.
