Eurojust and negotiations with a view to concluding a cooperation agreement with the Republic of Moldova

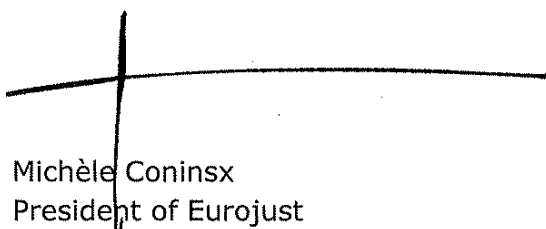
Dear Ms Tzika,
