Subject:	Work programme of the incoming Presidency Information from the Irish delegation

In view of the incoming Irish Presidency, the Telecommunications Council will be informed of the priorities under the heading of promoting sustainable growth and jobs, and building Europe's competitive advantage.

Based on the orientations set by the European Council, the Irish Presidency intends to focus its work on the legislative proposal on the proposed Regulation on guidelines for trans-European telecommunications networks and the Regulation on electronic identification and trust services. Other proposals to be progressed include the proposal on the accessibility of public sector bodies' websites, the forthcoming communication on Cyber Security together with the legislative proposal on network and information security and the legislative proposal on reducing the costs of broadband deployment.

These priorities set by the Irish Presidency will be reflected in the agenda of the TTE Council scheduled on 6 June 2013.
