1. The General Secretariat of the Council has been informed of the resignation of Mr Andreas GRUBER, as member of the above Committee in the employers' representatives category (for Austria).
2. Under Article 27 of Regulation (EEC) No 1612/68 on freedom of movement for workers within the Community, members and alternate members are appointed by the Council.

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN UNION,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 1612/68 of 15 October 1968 on freedom of movement for workers within the Community<sup>1</sup>, and in particular Articles 26 and 27 thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) In its Decision of 4 October 2012<sup>2</sup> and 20 November 2012<sup>3</sup>, the Council appointed the members and alternate members of the Advisory Committee on Freedom of Movement for Workers for the period ending on 24 September 2014.
- (2) A seat as member in the employers representatives category has fallen vacant as a result of the resignation of Mr Andreas GRUBER.
- (3) The Government of Austria has submitted a nomination for the vacant seat,
