SI was of the view that all Member States in financial difficulties, and not just those covered by the proposal, potentially should be able to benefit from the increased co-financing rate. NL called for an impact assessment. Following the exchange of views, it was concluded that there was sufficient support for the proposal of the Commission with a view to an agreement at first reading with the European Parliament.
