- On the basis of the draft comments provided by the Commission, the <u>Working Party of Chief</u> <u>Veterinary Officers</u> met on 19 December 2012 ¹ and 23 January 2013 ² to agree on EU positions with regard to the following OIE documents:
 - a) Report of the September 2012 meeting of the Terrestrial Animal Health Standards Commission;
 - B) Report of the September 2012 meeting of the OIE Aquatic Animal Health Standards Commission;
 - c) Draft chapters of the OIE Manual of Diagnostic Tests and Vaccines for Terrestrial Animals.

- 2. The discussion led to the following conclusions:
 - (a) The <u>Presidency</u> stated that there was <u>an agreement ³ on the texts under examination</u> and that the final versions could be forwarded to the OIE ⁴.
 - (b) The <u>Working Party</u> adhered to the position traditionally adopted in favour of forwarding a <u>letter</u>⁵ signed jointly by the <u>Presidency</u> and the <u>Commission</u> to communicate to the OIE the comments to be made on behalf of the Member States ⁶.

The <u>Commission</u> accordingly considers that the procedure followed in the case in question cannot constitute a precedent likely to be invoked for forthcoming OIE sessions or in other similar circumstances".

[&]quot;The <u>Commission</u> considers that the procedure followed for forwarding the EU comments to the World Organisation for Animal Health (both by the Presidency, on behalf of the Member States, and by the Commission) does not correspond to the procedures usually followed in similar cases (notably in the case of the Codex Alimentarius). The fact that the EU only has observer status with an international organisation does not prevent the Commission on its own from forwarding the EU comments.
