National DNA Analysis Files

<u>Declaration of the Republic of Malta</u> <u>in accordance with Article 2 (3) of Council Decision 2008/615/JHA</u>

The national DNA database operates on the basis of CODIS 7.0 (Combined DNA Index System), installed at the Malta Police Forensic Science Laboratory by officials from the FBI (United States), and is used in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 164 of the Laws of Malta.

From this database the following types of profiles are extracted:

- **Forensic:** genetic profile (unknown origin) obtained during a pre-trial investigation from the crime scene or directly from evidence in accordance with legal provisions associated with a criminal act.
- **Suspect:** genetic profile obtained from a known person. DNA profiles from suspects, offenders, arrestees and convicted persons are included.
- **Unidentified person:** genetic profile obtained from an unidentified dead body. DNA profiles from deceased, unidentified human remains, missing persons are included.

A country that wishes to carry out the exchange and comparison of profiles with Malta must comply with the legal, organisational and technical requirements laid down in Council Decisions 2008/615/JHA and 2008/616/JHA of 23 June 2008.
