On 13 December 2012, the Bremische Bürgerschaft [Bremen Parliament] decided on the following new nomination for the remainder of the CoR's fifth term:

It became necessary to nominate a new member due to Dr QUANTE-BRANDT's departure from the CoR.

The Federal Government hereby proposes that Ms Hiller be appointed as a member of the CoR for the remainder of the fifth term.

I would ask you to set in motion the procedure for appointment in accordance with Article 305 TFEU.

This does not affect the nomination of the alternate member for Bremen (Dr Hermann KUHN, Mitglied der Bremischen Bürgerschaft).
