Proposal for a Council Implementing Regulation imposing a definitive anti-dumping duty on imports of certain prepared or preserved citrus fruits (namely mandarins, etc.) originating in the People's Republic of China

Delegations are requested to examine the above revised text of the draft Council Implementing Regulation imposing a definitive anti-dumping duty on imports of certain prepared or preserved citrus fruits (namely mandarins, etc.) originating in the People's Republic of China, circulated on 6 February 2013 as document 6128/13 ANTIDUMPING 7 COMER 17, on which the Council should act as soon as possible.
