### Whereas:

- **(1)** The Commission has negotiated on behalf of the Union the Agreement between the European Union and the European Organisation for the Safety of Air Navigation providing a general framework for enhanced cooperation ("the Agreement").
- The Agreement was signed on 20 December 2012 subject to its conclusion at a later date. (2)
- (3) It is necessary to lay down procedural arrangements for the participation of the Union in the Joint Committee established by the Agreement.
- (4) The Agreement should be approved,

#### Article 1

The Agreement between the European Union and the European Organisation for the Safety of Air Navigation providing a general framework for enhanced cooperation is hereby approved on behalf of the Union<sup>1</sup>

#### Article 2

The President of the Council shall, on behalf of the Union, give the notification provided for in point 13.2 of the Agreement.

## Article 3

The Commission shall represent the Union within the Joint Committee set up pursuant to point 7 of the Agreement.

#### Article 4

1. The Commission, after consultation with the Special Committee appointed by the Council, shall determine the position to be taken by the Union in the Joint Committee, concerning the implementation of the Agreement and with respect to the adoption of Annexes to the Agreement and the amendments of such Annexes.
