Subject: Anti-dumping

Proposal for a Council Implementing Regulation extending the definitive anti dumping duty imposed by Council Implementing Regulation (EU) No 2/2012 on imports of certain stainless steel fasteners and parts thereof originating in the People's Republic of China to imports of certain stainless steel fasteners consigned from the Philippines, whether declared as originating in the Philippines or not and terminating the investigation concerning possible circumvention of anti-dumping measures imposed by that regulation by imports of certain stainless steel fasteners and parts thereof consigned from Malaysia and Thailand, whether declared as originating in Malaysia and Thailand or not

Delegations are requested to examine the above Commission proposal, circulated on 13 February 2013 as document 6409/13 ANTIDUMPING 8 COMER 23, on which the Council should act as soon as possible.

If no comments have been received by the General Secretariat of the Council (e-mailed to *secretariat.polcom@consilium.europa.eu* or faxed to 02/281.73.74) before **Wednesday**, **20 February 2013 (noon)**, the proposal will be submitted for approval to the Permanent Representatives Committee (Part 2, meeting on 28 February 2013, as "I" item), with a view to its adoption as "A" item by the Council at its meeting on 7 March 2013. Publication in the Official Journal is scheduled for 12 March 2013.
