INFORMATION NOTE

Subject:	Case before the EU General Court:
	- Case T-563/12 (Central Bank of Iran v. the Council of the European Union)

- 1. By an application notified to the Council on 6 February 2013, the Central Bank of Iran has brought an action for the annulment, pursuant to Article 263 TFEU, of Council Implementing Regulation (EU) No 945/2012 and Council Decision 2012/635/CSFP, both of 15 October 2012, insofar as those acts relate to it (restrictive measures against Iran).
- 2. The applicant invokes the following grounds in support of its claim for annulment:
 - Manifest error in the assessment of the criteria for listing in the contested acts;
 - Failure to give adequate reasons;
 - Breach of the rights of the defence and to effective judicial review;
 - Violation of the applicant's right to protection of its property and reputation.

The Director-General of the Council Legal Service has appointed Mr Vincent PIESSEVAUX and Mr Michael BISHOP, members of the Legal Service, as the Council's agents in the case.
