Subject:	Written procedure for the adoption of the proposal for a Council Implementing Regulation extending the definitive anti-dumping duty imposed by Council Implementing Regulation (EU) No 467/2010 on imports of silicon originating in the People's Republic of China to imports of silicon consigned from Taiwan, whether declared as originating in Taiwan or not

On 11 March 2013, the Commission submitted the above proposal (doc. 7384/13 ANTIDUMPING 30 COMER 63). This Regulation should be published in the Official Journal on 5 April 2013 at the latest.

In view of the urgency of the matter, the Presidency has proposed using a written procedure pursuant to Article 12 of the Council's Rules of Procedure<sup>1</sup>.
