Page 1 and 2 of doc. 8088/12 INIT should read as follows:

**INTRODUCTION**

In accordance with Article 6(1) of Council Regulation (EC) No 377/2004 of 19 February 2004<sup>1</sup> on the creation of an immigration liaison officers network as amended by Regulation (EU) No 493/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 5 April 2011<sup>2</sup> "The Member State holding the Presidency of the Council of the European Union or, where that Member State is not represented in the country or region concerned, the Member State serving as acting Presidency shall draw up, by the end of each semester, a report to the European Parliament, the Council and the Commission on the activities of immigration liaison officers networks in specific countries and/or regions of particular interest to the Union, as well as on the situation in those countries and/or regions, in matters relating to illegal immigration, taking into consideration all the relevant aspects, including human rights...". It should also be recalled that according to Article 4(1) of the Regulation (EC) No 377/2004 all ILOs posted in the third country concerned are to contribute to this report.

This report has two parts:

**(I) Activities of the ILO Network**

**(II) Situation in the host country in matters relating to illegal immigration.**

The report should be based on facts and figures whenever applicable and on available and reliable sources of information. If such sources do not exist, this should be indicated in the report. Statistical data should be provided by Member States in accordance with the relevant definitions. Descriptions and evaluations requested by this format should be reasonably brief and supported by facts, if possible. In the report, please highlight only the most relevant information so as to enable correct assessment of the situation. If no significant change has occurred in respect of matters already covered in previous reports, a reference should be made to this. Where applicable, the report should focus on developments during the reporting period as compared with the previous report drawn up on that host country.

The completed report is to be treated as a 'RESTREINT UE' document and the relevant provisions of Council Decision (EU) No 2011/292 of 31 March 2011 on the security rules for protecting EU classified information must be observed.
