Subject:	Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) No/ of 18.2.2013 supplementing Directive 2010/30/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council with regard to the energy labelling of space heaters, combination heaters, packages of space heater, temperature control and solar device and packages of combination heater, temperature control and solar device - Intention not to raise objections to a delegated act

<u>The Commission</u> has submitted the above delegated act¹ to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and with Article 10 of Directive 2010/30/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council on the indication by labelling and standard product information of the consumption of energy and other resources by energy-related products ². The Commission having notified the delegated act with regard to energy labelling of space heaters, combination heaters, packages of space heater, temperature control and solar device and packages of combination heater, temperature control and solar device on 26 February 2013, the Council may object to it until 26 April 2013.

- 2. <u>The Working Party on Energy</u> has examined the delegated act and agreed that there are no grounds for the Council to object to it.
- 3. It is therefore suggested that <u>Coreper</u> recommend that <u>the Council</u> confirm that it has no intention to object to the delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof. This implies that, unless <u>the European Parliament</u> objects to it, the delegated act shall be published and enter into force in accordance with Article 13 of Directive 2010/30/EU.
