2) Languages in which MLA requests should be forwarded

In all cases Greek and in urgent cases English.

3) Procedures for forwarding request

There are no specific procedures. The request should be transmitted in written through the Central authority.

4) None, unless special cases concerning foreign affairs, immunities etc.

5) There is a technical problem about videoconference.

6) Double criminality requirement, if applicable

Always it should exist the principle of dual criminality.

7) In all cases according to our legal system.
