Subject:	Fourteenth Regular Session of the FAO Commission on Genetic Resources for Food and Agriculture (Rome, 15-19 April 2013)

At its meeting on 3 April 2013, the <u>Working Party on Genetic Resources in Agriculture</u> discussed preparations for the fourteenth regular session of the FAO Commission on Genetic Resources for Food and Agriculture (CGRFA14), which will take place in Rome from 15 to 19 April 2013.

In addition to considering draft position papers and statements, it examined the draft declaration of competences and voting rights proposed by the <u>Commission</u>. In accordance with the FAO General Rules, the EU must submit such a declaration to the FAO Secretariat before all FAO meetings.

The meeting noted that, while the <u>Commission</u> had initially proposed "shared competence - EU vote" for six items on the CGRFA14 agenda, it had modified its proposal to "shared competence - MS vote" for five of them (see Annex). It insisted, however, on an EU vote for agenda item 2.4, "Consideration of the need for and modalities of access and benefit-sharing arrangements for genetic resources for food and agriculture".

<u>Several delegations</u> objected to an EU vote for agenda item 2.4 and expressed the view that voting by Member States remained appropriate for that agenda item. They argued that the position had not changed since the previous CGRFA meeting in 2011, for which <u>Coreper</u> had approved a declaration of competences and voting rights indicating "shared competence - MS vote" for all agenda items, including that on access and benefit-sharing (cf. docs 12818/11 and 12901/11).

The <u>representative of the Commission</u> argued that the situation had indeed changed since 2011, in particular because, in October 2012, the Commission presented to the Council and the Parliament a draft Regulation with the objective of establishing uniform user compliance rules throughout the Union covering all users and all uses of genetic resources, including for food and agriculture, so as to permit EU ratification of the Nagoya Protocol to the Convention on Biological Diversity. For that reason, it was appropriate for the European Commission to take the lead on behalf of the Union and its Member States on the issue of access and benefit-sharing.

<u>Several delegations</u> did not accept this argument, on the grounds that the proposed Regulation had yet to be adopted.

The <u>Presidency</u> concluded that there was no agreement on the voting arrangements for CGRFA14 agenda item 2.4 and that the issue would need to be discussed again at the <u>FAO Coordination</u> Working Party meeting on 10 April 2013.

The <u>representative of the Commission</u> reserved his institution's right to refer the matter to <u>Coreper</u>, if necessary.
