## **INFORMATION NOTE**

Subject:	Case before the EU General Court:
	- Case T-74/13 (Mazen AL-TABBAA against Council of the European Union)

- 1. By an application notified to the Council on 15 February 2013, Mr Mazen AL-TABBAA has brought an action for annulment, pursuant to Articles 263 TFEU, against Council Decision 2012/739/CFSP of 29 November 2012 concerning restrictive measures against Syria and repealing Decision 2011/782/CFSP, and Council Implementing Regulation (EU) No 1117/2012 of 29 November 2012 implementing Article 32 (1) of Regulation (EU) No 36/2012 concerning restrictive measures against Syria, insofar those acts concern the applicant.
- 2. The applicant invokes the following grounds for annulment:
  - manifest error of assessment.
  - violation of the duty to state reasons;
  - violation of the applicant's rights of defence and to effective judicial protection;
  - breach of applicant's fundamental rights, including his right to property, to conduct his business, to reputation, and to private and family life.
- 3. The Director-General of the Council Legal Service has appointed Mr. Vincent PIESSEVAUX and Ms. Sophia KYRIAKOPOULOU, members of the Legal Service, as the Council's agents in the case.
