Subject:	Adoption of a Council Decision on the signing, on behalf of the Union, of the Agreement between the European Union and the Russian Federation on drug precursors <b>COMMON GUIDELINES</b>
	Consultation deadline for Croatia: 17.4.2013

 On 21 January 2013, <u>the Commission</u> submitted to the Council the above proposal, which aims at strengthening the cooperation between the Union and the Russian federation to prevent the diversion of drug precursors from the legal trade to counter the illicit manufacture of narcotic drugs. The proposal is based on Art. 207(4) first subparagraph in conjunction with Art. 218(5) of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union.

- 2. At its meeting on 27 February 2013, <u>the Working Party on Customs Union</u> reached agreement<sup>1</sup> on an amended text of this proposal.<sup>2</sup>
- 3. <u>The Permanent Representatives Committee</u> could therefore:
  - confirm the agreement reached within the Working Party; and
  - invite <u>the Council</u> to adopt the Council Decision as set out in document 7767/13 UD 66
    OC 167 and 8178/13 UD 72 OC 185 (texts revised by the legal-linguistic experts)
    as an item without discussion at one of its forthcoming meetings.
