Subject: Proposal for transfer of appropriations No DEC 06/2013 within Section III -

Commission - of the general budget for 2013

1. On 16 April 2013, the Commission submitted to the Council proposal for transfer of appropriations No DEC 06/2013.

The purpose of this proposal is to transfer an amount of EUR 38 million in commitment and EUR 12 million in payment appropriations from Article 40 02 42 (*Emergency aid reserve*) to Article 23 02 02 (*Food aid*), as recorded in document 8474/13 FIN 191.

- 2. The transfer is being proposed in order to provide food aid to respond to the increased needs in the crisis in the Sahel region and Chad with an amount of EUR 38 million.
- 3. The Budget Committee examined the proposal for a transfer at its meeting on 19 April 2013.

- 4. In accordance with the provisions of Point 25 of the Interinstitutional Agreement of 17 May 2006, a simplified trilogue was held on the Commission proposal.
- 5. Following that examination, the Budget Committee agreed, by a qualified majority, to suggest that the Permanent Representatives Committee advise the Council to approve:
  - the proposed transfer of appropriations;
  - the draft letter in ANNEX to that effect.
