Subject: Adoption of a Council Regulation on the waiver from the requirement to submit entry and exit summary declarations for Union goods that are moved across the Neum corridor

**COMMON GUIDELINES**  
**Consultation deadline: 30.04.2013**

---

1. By letter dated 11 January 2013, the Commission submitted to the Council the above proposal, based on Article 3(4) of the Accession Treaty of Croatia and Article 43 on the Act concerning the Conditions of Accession of Croatia, and aiming at defining the terms under which the requirements for an entry or exit summary declaration may be waived as regards goods that are being moved through the Neum corridor.
2. On 20 March 2013, the Working Party on Customs Union reached an agreement on an amended version of the draft Regulation, as laid down in doc. 6992/2/13 REV 2.

3. Against this background, the Permanent Representatives Committee could:

- confirm the agreement reached within the Working Party and
- invite the Council to adopt the draft Regulation as set out in doc. 8214/13 UD 77 ELARG 60 COWEB 46 OC 217 (text revised by legal/linguistic experts) as an item without discussion at one of its forthcoming meetings.
