Subject : **Anti-dumping**

Proposal for a Council Implementing Regulation amending Regulation (EC)
No 192/2007 imposing a definitive anti-dumping duty on imports of certain
polyethylene terephthalate (PET) originating in India, Indonesia, Malaysia, the
Republic of Korea, Thailand and Taiwan

1. On 24 April 2013, the Commission submitted the above proposal for an Implementing Regulation to the Council, which is requested to take a decision on it as soon as possible.
2. Delegations were consulted on this proposal (see CM 2606/13) and all agreed with the proposal.

3. Pursuant to Article 9 of Council Regulation (EC) 1225/2009 of 30 November 2009 on protection against dumped imports from countries not members of the European Community¹, the proposal shall be adopted by the Council unless it decides by a simple majority to reject it.
 4. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore invited to recommend that, as an "A" item on the agenda, the Council adopt the Implementing Regulation as finalised by the Legal/Linguistic experts and set out in document 8886/13 ANTIDUMPING 52 COMER 101.
