Subject: Anti-dumping

Proposal for a Council Implementing Regulation extending the definitive anti-dumping duty imposed by Council Implementing Regulation (EU) No 990/2011 on imports of bicycles originating in the People's Republic of China by imports of bicycles consigned from Indonesia, Malaysia, Sri Lanka and Tunisia, whether declared as originating in Indonesia, Malaysia, Sri Lanka and Tunisia or not

Delegations are requested to examine the above Commission proposal, circulated on 7 May 2013 as document 9343/13 ANTIDUMPING 57 COMER 112, on which the Council should act as soon as possible.

If no comments have been received by the General Secretariat of the Council (e-mailed to *secretariat.polcom@consilium.europa.eu* or faxed to 02/281.73.74) before **Thursday**, **16 May 2013 (noon)**, the proposal will be submitted for approval to the Permanent Representatives Committee (Part 2, meeting on 23 May 2013, as "I" item), with a view to its adoption as "A" item by the Council at its meeting on 29 May 2013. Publication in the Official Journal is scheduled for 5 June 2013.
