On page 3, the first paragraph should read as follows:

## III. ANALYSIS OF THE COMMON POSITION

## 1. General

The Council, in its position at first reading, shares the proposal's overall objective with regard to the need to strengthen the enforcement by customs of intellectual property rights. However, the Council takes the view that the scope of the Regulation should <u>not</u> be extended to parallel trade and overruns, and that the right to be heard should be granted in accordance with national law, and in addition introduces an number of technical changes to the proposal.
