## Statement by the Council and the Commission to be entered in the Minutes of the Council

Before concluding the WIPO Beijing Treaty on Audiovisual Performances, the EU and the Member States will examine together to which extent it is necessary to make a reservation as provided for in Article 11(3) and to deposit a notification as provided for in Article 11(2) and Article 19(2) of that Treaty, taking into consideration the financial consequences for European performers and users.
