	- Case T-182/13, Moallem Insurance Co. v. Council

- 1. By an application notified to the Council on 26 April 2013, the above-mentioned company has brought an action for the annulment, pursuant to Articles 263 and 275 TFEU, of paragraph 18 of the Annex to Council Decision 2012/829/CFSP of 21 December 2012 amending Decision 2010/413/CFSP concerning restrictive measures against Iran as well as of paragraph 18 of the Annex to Council Implementing Regulation (EU) No 1264/2012 of 21 December 2012 implementing Regulation (EU) No 267/2012 concerning restrictive measures against Iran, in so far as they relate to the applicant. The application is also made for a declaration of illegality and / or inapplicability of Article 12 of Council Decision 2010/413/CFSP of 26 July 2010, and of Article 35 of Council Regulation 267/2012 of 23 March 2012 in so far as these relate to the applicant.
- 2. The applicant invokes the following grounds in support of its claims for annulment and declaration of inapplicability:
 - Erroneous and insufficient reasons were given for the applicant's designations;

- Breach of the rights of the defence, of the right to a fair hearing and of the obligation to provide sufficient reasons;
- Violation of Articles 24(3) and 24(4) of Council Decision 2010/413/CFSP and of Articles 46(3) and 46(4) of Council Regulation EU 267/2012;
- Breach of the principle of sound administration;
- Breach of the principle of legitimate expectations and of the principle of proportionality;
- Violation of Article 215 (20) and (3) TFEU and Article 40 TEU;
- Violation of the principles of equality and of non-discrimination.
- The Director-General of the Council Legal Service has appointed Mr Alessandro VITRO and 3. Mr Michael BISHOP, members of the Legal Service, as the Council's agents in this case.
