	– Extension of the period for raising objections

- The <u>Commission</u> submitted the above mentioned delegated act to the Council in accordance with Article 290 of the TFEU and Article 7 of Directive 2010/40/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 7 July 2010 on the framework for the deployment of Intelligent Transport Systems in the field of road transport and for interfaces with other modes of transport¹.
- The Commission notified this act on 15 May 2013. In accordance with Article 14 of Directive 2010/40/EU, the Council may object to this delegated act within a period of two months from the notification (i.e. up to 14 July 2013).

- On 12 June 2013, the <u>Working Party on Transport Intermodal Questions and Network</u> examined this issue and agreed to invite the Council to decide to extend the period for raising objections by two months.
- 4. It is therefore suggested that the <u>Permanent Representatives Committee</u> confirm this position and recommend to the Council to:
 - decide to extend the period for raising objections on this delegated Regulation by two months and
 - agree to inform accordingly the European Parliament and the Commission.
