Subject: COMMISSION DELEGATED REGULATION (EU) No .../.. of 15.5.2013 supplementing Directive 2010/40/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council with regard to data and procedures for the provision, where possible, of road safety-related minimum universal traffic information free of charge to users
– *Extension of the period for raising objections*

1. The Commission submitted the above mentioned delegated act to the Council in accordance with Article 290 of the TFEU and Article 7 of Directive 2010/40/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 7 July 2010 on the framework for the deployment of Intelligent Transport Systems in the field of road transport and for interfaces with other modes of transport¹.
2. The Commission notified this act on 15 May 2013. In accordance with Article 14 of Directive 2010/40/EU, the Council may object to this delegated act within a period of two months from the notification (i.e. up to 14 July 2013).

3. On 12 June 2013, the Working Party on Transport Intermodal Questions and Network examined this issue and agreed to invite the Council to decide to extend the period for raising objections by two months.

4. It is therefore suggested that the Permanent Representatives Committee confirm this position and recommend to the Council to:
 - decide to extend the period for raising objections on this delegated Regulation by two months and
 - agree to inform accordingly the European Parliament and the Commission.
