Subject:	Proposal for a Council Regulation amending Regulation (EU) No 1259/2012 on the allocation of the fishing opportunities provided for in the Fisheries Partnership Agreement between the European Union and the Islamic Republic of Mauritania - adoption

- 1. <u>The European Commission</u> submitted its proposal to the Council on 14 June 2013 in order to amend the allocation of licences in Category 5 and Category 6 of the Regulation.
- 2. <u>The Working Party on Internal and External Fisheries Policy</u> examined the proposal and reached an agreement on the text in its session on 21 June 2013.
- 3. The French and United Kingdom delegations entered Parliamentary scrutiny reservations.
- 4. Consequently, COREPER is invited to confirm the agreement reached at the level of the Working Party and to suggest that Council adopts the Regulation as set out in doc. 11517/13 PECHE 279 (as finalised by the legal-linguistic experts) at one of its forth-coming sessions.
