Subject:	Adoption of a Council Decision on the position to be adopted by the European Union, in the context of the EU-Switzerland Joint Committee, on the definition of the grounds for exemption from transmitting data pursuant to the first subparagraph of Article 3(3) of Annex 1 to the Agreement between the European Community and the Swiss Confederation on the simplification of inspections and formalities in respect of the carriage of goods and on customs security measures <b>COMMON GUIDELINES</b> Consultation deadline for Croatia: 25.6.2013

 On 4 April 2013, <u>the Commission</u> submitted to the Council the above proposal, which aims at providing for an exemption from transmitting security data for some indirect exports made by air. The proposal is based on Art. 207(4) first subparagraph in conjunction with Art. 218(9) of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union.

- 2. At its meeting on 18 June 2013, <u>the Working Party on Customs Union</u> reached agreement on an amended text of this proposal.<sup>1</sup>
- 3. In these circumstances, given the urgency of the entry in force of this Decision, <u>the Permanent</u> <u>Representatives Committee</u> is invited to endorse the use of the <u>written procedure</u> for its formal adoption. The procedure will be launched by the General Secretariat of the Council.
