	- Agreement on the use of the written procedure for the adoption

- On 8 July 2013, <u>the Commission</u> submitted to Council its proposal for a Council Regulation establishing the fishing opportunities for anchovy in the Bay of Biscay for the 2013-2014 fishing season.
- On 11 July 2013, the Working Party on Internal and External Fisheries Policy examined the proposal and reached an agreement on it. <u>The Danish, French, and United Kingdom</u> delegations entered Parliamentary scrutiny reservations.
- 3. In these circumstances, given the urgency of a timely publication of this Regulation in view of the fishing season, <u>the Permanent Representatives Committee</u> is invited to <u>endorse the use</u> of the written procedure for its formal adoption. The procedure will be launched by the General Secretariat of the Council once the legal/linguistic experts have finalised their work (doc. 12210/13 PECHE 320).
