Subject :	Proposal for transfer of appropriations No DEC 21/2013 within Section III - Commission - of the general budget for 2013

 On 5 July 2013, the Commission submitted to the Council proposal for transfer of appropriations No DEC 21/2013.

The purpose of this proposal is to transfer a total amount of EUR 21 million in payment appropriations from Chapters 19 03 (*Common foreign and security policy (CFSP)*) and 19 04 (*European Instrument for Democracy and human Rights (EIDHR)*) to Item 19 06 01 01 (*Crisis response and preparedness (Instrument for Stability)*), as recorded in document 11828/13 FIN 396.

2. The transfer is being proposed to reinforce the Instrument for Stability in order to cover the most urgent contractual obligations.

- 3. The <u>Budget Committee</u> examined this proposal for a transfer at its meeting on 9 and 11 July 2013.
- 4. Following that examination, the <u>Budget Committee</u> agreed, by a qualified majority, to suggest that the Permanent Representatives Committee advise the Council to approve:
 - the proposed transfer of appropriations;
 - the draft letter in the ANNEX to that effect.
