Subject: Proposal for transfer of appropriations No DEC 16/2013 within Section III -

Commission - of the general budget for 2013

1. On 5 July 2013, the Commission submitted to the Council proposal for transfer of appropriations No DEC 16/2013.

The purpose of this proposal is to transfer a total amount of EUR 4 060 000 in payment appropriations from Article 01 04 05 (*Completion of programme for enterprises: improvement of the financial environment for small and middle-seized enterprises (SMEs)*) to Item 26 03 01 01 (*Interoperability Solutions for European Public Administrations (ISA)*), as recorded in document 11823/13 FIN 392.

2. The transfer is being proposed to reinforce the resources available in the EU budget for projects related to the establishment of the electronic cross-border and cross-sector interaction between public administrations and to clear pending invoices in order to avoid late interests.

- 3. The Budget Committee examined this proposal for a transfer at its meeting on 9 and 11 July 2013.
- 4. Following that examination, <u>the Budget Committee</u> agreed, by a qualified majority, to suggest that the Permanent Representatives Committee advise the Council to approve:
 - the proposed transfer of appropriations;
 - the draft letter in the ANNEX to that effect.
