Subject:	Case before the Court of Justice of the European Union
	- Case C-306/13 (LVP)

- 1. The Tribunal of First Instance of Brussels has by decision of 17 May 2013, lodged on 6 June 2013, requested the Court of Justice to give a preliminary ruling pursuant to Article 267 TFEU, pertaining to the validity of Council Regulation (EC) No 1964 of 29 November 2005 on the tariff rates for bananas (OJ L 316, 2.12.2005, p. 1).
- 2. The question referred to the Court of Justice is whether the above Regulation, as applied by the European Union for the period starting from 1 January 2006 up to and including 15 December 2009, is in breach of Article I, Article XIII, subparagraph 1, Article XIII, subparagraph 2 (d), Article XXVIII; and/ or any other applicable provision of GATT 1994, either separately or jointly, because it introduces a tariff rate for the import of bananas (CN code 0803 00 19) of EUR 176/tonne, in breach of the concessions negotiated by the EC for bananas, prior to a new negotiated agreement having been reached on the matter in the framework of the WTO.

- 3. The Council is, according to Article 23 of the Statute of the Court of Justice, entitled to submit observations within two months of receipt of the notification, in a case governed by Article 267 of the TFEU if the act, the validity or interpretation of which is in dispute, originates from the Council.
- 4. The Director-General of the Council Legal Service has appointed Ms. Sonja BOELAERT and Ms Eva KARLSSON as the Council's agents in this case.
