Subject:	Written procedure for the adoption of the Proposal for a Council implementing regulation imposing a definitive anti-dumping duty on imports of certain prepared or preserved sweetcorn in kernels originating in Thailand following an expiry review pursuant to Article 11(2) of Regulation (EC) No 1225/2009

On 2 August 2013, the Commission submitted the above proposal (doc. 12948/13 ANTIDUMPING 70 COMER 185 LIMITE). This Regulation should be published in the Official Journal on 13 September 2013 at the latest.
