#### d) Detailed grounds for the increase

Following negotiations with representatives of the Gabonese Republic, a new Protocol to the Fisheries Partnership Agreement was initialled on 24 April 2013. On 27 June 2013 the Commission adopted the legislative proposals resulting from these negotiations.

On 22 July 2013 the Council adopted the decision on the provisional application of the new Protocol. In accordance with Article 14 of the Protocol, its provisional application will begin on the date on which it is signed.

The budget allocation is therefore needed in operational line 11 03 01 in order to make the commitments and payments arising from the abovementioned legal base for 2013, which come to a total of EUR 1 350 000.
