COMMISSION DELEGATED REGULATION (EU) No .../.. of 15.5.2013  
supplementing ITS Directive 2010/40/EU of the European Parliament and of the

– Decision not to oppose adoption

Following the transmission by the Commission on 15 May 2013 of the above **draft delegated act** in accordance with Article 290 of the TFEU and Article 7 of Directive 2010/40/EU<sup>1</sup> and the decision by the Council to extend the period for raising objections to this draft delegated act by two months in accordance with Article 14 of Directive 2010/40/EU, the Council should decide by 14 September 2013 whether it has the intention to object to the draft delegated act and its corrigendum.
