Subject :	Report on the implementation of the obligations under the Convention on Nuclear Safety - 6th Review meeting of the Contracting Parties

The European Atomic Energy Community (Euratom) and Member States are Parties to the Convention on Nuclear Safety. In accordance with Article 5 of the Convention, each Party must submit a report on the measures it has taken to implement each of the obligations of the Convention. Those reports will be examined at the next (6<sup>th</sup>) review meeting, to be held from 24 March to 4 April 2014.
