Subject:	Council Decision to authorise the Commission to open negotiations on behalf of the European Union for a new Protocol to the Fisheries Partnership Agreement with the Democratic Republic of São Tomé and Príncipe - Adoption

1. On 9 July 2013 the <u>Commission</u> submitted a recommendation to the Council to authorise the opening of negotiations between the European Union and the Republic of São Tomé and Príncipe for a new Protocol to the Fisheries Partnership Agreement. The current protocol will expire on 12 May 2014. The Commission services wish to open negotiations in mid-October this year.

2. <u>The Working Party on Internal and External Fisheries Policy</u> examined the recommendation during its meeting on 5 and 12 September 2013. The <u>French and Netherlands delegations</u> entered parliamentary scrutiny reserves. The <u>Swedish and United Kingdom delegations</u> entered general scrutiny reserves. <u>The Netherlands and the United Kingdom delegations</u> highlighted that a series of negative points had been noted in the evaluation report.

3. The Working Party agreed on a draft mandate for the opening of negotiations, including negotiating directives, as contained in doc. ST 13624/13 PECHE 377.

4. Under these circumstances, the <u>Committee of Permanent Representatives</u> could confirm the agreement reached at the level of the Working Party and suggests that <u>Council</u>, at one of its forthcoming sessions:

- adopt the Decision on opening negotiations and to adopt the negotiation directives as set out in doc. ST 13624/13 PECHE 377;

- decide not to publish the Decision in accordance with Article 17(2)(b) of its Rules of Procedure;

- note that the European Parliament will be informed in accordance with Article 218(10) TFEU, and therefore a paper copy of the Decision including the negotiating directives will be transmitted to the Parliament;

- enter the Commission statement in the Addendum to this note in the minutes of the Council.
