"Germany wishes to emphasize its concerns regarding the Commission's proposal for a comitology "Omnibus regulation". Germany can agree to the Presidency proposal to activate a FoP Group in the understanding that the following overall conditions for the further works apply:

- For each legal act a review on a case-by-case basis without prejudice to its outcome is necessary; any automatism is to be rejected. In the draft decision on the activation of the FoP Group, the Presidency rightly points out that an automatic en-bloc alignment of PRAC procedures to delegated acts is not possible and insofar also refers to the advisory opinion of the Council's Legal Service of 11 April 2011, which constitutes an essential orientation also for Germany.
- The "Omnibus-regulation" has to be limited to those cases, which can be aligned to the procedure of delegated acts without problems (in particular without further amendments to the conferral of powers in the basic legal acts) following a case-by-case review, and where amendments/evaluations of the basic legal act are not envisaged anyway.
- The phrasing in the FoP's mandate regarding the request for expert opinion from the expert working groups ("as necessary") is misleading. Based on the reviews being carried out so far, Germany considers the involvement of the expert working groups to be necessary in all cases.
- The Commission has not complied with its obligation to substantiate the reasons for the alignment of the legal acts; it has only claimed a case-by-case review in general terms. The Commission should substantiate the reasons for its proposal for the alignment to delegated legal acts in each single case.
- Germany reserves its right to examine the question of the handling of the announced third "Omnibus-regulation" of the Commission in the light of the actual proposal and to possibly revert to this issue."
