Subject:	Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) No/ of 21.8.2013 amending Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 114/2013 for the purpose of correcting the 2010 average specific CO2 emissions specified for the manufacturer Piaggio
	- Intention not to raise objection to a delegated act

1. The <u>Commission</u> has submitted the above delegated act¹ to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and Article 11(7) of Regulation (EU) No 510/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 11 May 2011 setting emission performance standards for new light commercial vehicles as part of the Union's integrated approach to reduce CO2 emissions from light-duty vehicles². The Commission having notified the delegated act amending Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 114/2013 for the purpose of correcting the 2010 average specific CO2 emissions specified for the manufacturer Piaggio on 21 August 2013, the Council may object to it until 21 October 2013.

- 2. The Working Party on Environment has examined the delegated act and agreed that there are no grounds for the Council to object it.
- 3. It is therefore suggested that <u>Coreper</u> recommend that the <u>Council</u> confirm that it has no intention to object to the delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof. This implies that, unless the <u>European Parliament</u> objects to it, the delegated act shall be published and enter into force on the twentieth day following its publication in the Official Journal of the European Union in accordance with Article 2 of the Delegated Regulation.
