THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,

Having regard to Regulation (EC) No 1338/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 16 December 2008 on Community statistics on public health and health and safety at work, and in particular Article 9(1) thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) Annex II to Commission Regulation (EU) No 141/2013¹ provides for the minimum effective sample size, calculated on the assumption of simple random sampling.
- (2) It is necessary to adapt Annex II to Regulation (EU) No 141/2013 to take into account the accession of Croatia.
- (3) Regulation (EU) No 141/2013 should therefore be amended accordingly.
- (4) The measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the opinion of the European Statistical System Committee,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

Annex II to Regulation (EU) No 141/2013 is replaced by the text set out in the Annex to this Regulation.

Article 2
