amending Regulation (EU) No 648/2012 of the European Parliament and of the
Council on OTC derivatives, central counterparties and trade repositories with
regard to the list of exempted entities
- Intention not to raise objections to delegated acts

1. On 12 July 2013 the Commission submitted the abovementioned delegated acts¹ to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and Article 82 of Regulation (EU) No 648/2012 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 4 July 2012 on on OTC derivatives, central counterparties and trade repositories².

2. According to Article 82(6) of Regulation (EU) No 648/2012, the Council may object to a delegated act within a period of three months.
3. During the silence procedure within the framework of Working Party on Financial Services, no delegation indicated an intention to object to the delegated act.
4. It is therefore suggested that Coreper invites the Council at a forthcoming meeting to confirm that the Council has no intention to object to the delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof; this implies that, unless the European Parliament objects to it, the delegated act shall be published and enter into force in accordance with Article 82(6) of Regulation (EU) No 648/2012.
