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Subject: Proposal for a Directive of the European Parliament and of the Council on railway safety (Recast)  
- *General approach*

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On page 64 of document 14258/13, Article 22, paragraph 3 should read as follows:

The investigation shall be carried out with as much openness as possible, so that all parties can be heard and can share the results. The relevant infrastructure manager and railway undertakings, the national safety authority, the Agency, victims and their relatives, owners of damaged property, manufacturers, the emergency services involved and representatives of staff and users shall be given an opportunity to **provide technical relevant information in order to improve the quality of the investigation report** ~~comment on the information in draft reports~~. The investigating body shall also take account of the reasonable needs of the victims and their relatives and keep them informed regarding the progress.<sup>24</sup>
