Subject: Anti-dumping

Proposal for a Council Implementing Regulation terminating the partial interim review concerning the anti-dumping measures on imports of certain iron or steel fasteners originating in the People's Republic of China, as extended to imports consigned from Malaysia, whether declared as originating in Malaysia or not

- 1. On 23 September 2013, the Commission submitted the above proposal for an Implementing Regulation to the Council, which is requested to take a decision on it as soon as possible.
- 2. Delegations were consulted on this proposal (see CM 4479/13).
- 3. All twenty eight delegations were in favour of the Commission proposal.

- 4. Pursuant to Article 9 of Council Regulation (EC) 1225/2009 of 30 November 2009 on protection against dumped imports from countries not members of the European Community¹, the proposal shall be adopted by the Council <u>unless it decides by a simple majority to reject it.</u>
- 5. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore invited to recommend that, as an "A" item on the agenda, the Council adopt the Implementing Regulation as finalised by the Legal/Linguistic experts and set out in document 14060/13 ANTIDUMPING 85 COMER 220.
